David McDaid is Associate Professor in Health Policy and Health Economics at the Personal Social Services Research Unit at the London School of Economics and Political Science. He is also an associate of the WHO European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies. He has more than 20 years of research experience and over 350 publications related to different aspects of the economics and policy of mental health and public health in Europe and beyond. This has included work looking at the economic impacts of investment in the promotion of mental health and treatment of mental health problems on physical health and wellbeing and the costs of physical/mental multi-morbidity. He also has undertaken extensive work comparing the financing and organisation of different mental health systems in different countries, as well as recent work for the OECD mapping mental health promotion and disorder prevention services.
