

## **Michael Sharpe**

Michael Sharpe is Professor of Psychological Medicine at the University of Oxford and leads psychiatry and psychology services in Oxford University Hospitals. After initially studying Experimental Psychology in Oxford he trained in Medicine and then in Psychiatry in Cambridge and Oxford. His research has focussed on how best to integrate psychiatric and medical care for people with chronic medical illnesses, especially cancer.

Professor Sharpe was the UK Royal College of Psychiatrists “Psychiatric Academic of the Year” in 2009 and “Psychiatrist of the Year” in 2014. He received the Don R Lipsett award for achievement in integrated care from the American Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine in 2015 and the Alison Creed award from the European Association of Psychosomatic Medicine in 2016.
